NSW All Schools Manager-in-charge

This person will be responsible for coordinating all NSW teams for the respective sport at the School Sport Australia national championships and liaising with the NSW Sport Programs Coordinator regarding all tour logistics. - CIS NSW for Independent School teachers and staff

 - If your role is awaiting approval, your school will show with a yellow tag next to it (see below). If it is active, it will have a green tag.
