**Trial Finish Time:** 3:30pm

**Event Overview:** This will be a skills, drills & scrimmage games Trial. Twelve (12) athletes will be selected for the CIS Secondary Girls 18&U Softball team. The selected team will be available for viewing on the CIS Website post the event.

**What to Bring:** Kit, food, water & sun protection. Players should be prepared with enough food for the day.

**What to Wear:** All triallists should wear their Association or School Sports uniform. No State or Representative uniform should be worn, including caps, helmet stickers etc.

Metal cleats are not permitted at the CIS trial nor the NSW All Schools Tournament
