Event Overview: The trial format is individual involving game skills and drills. At the conclusion of the trials, 16 students will be named in the 2026 CIS Secondary 18&U Baseball Team. The team list will be announced to the triallists on the day and be available to view on the CIS website.

What to Bring: Please bring all snacks and lunch, along with plenty of water as there will be no opportunity to purchase food or drink at the venue. Students should also bring a bat, ball and catchers gear if trialling for this position.

What to Wear: All triallists should wear their Club or School Sports uniform. All students must have protective gear which should include box and batting helmet.

General Information

Selection Note: Selections are based on the performance of all students on the day.

Areas of performance considered include:

- Skills exhibited by the player;
- Fitness level exhibited by the player;
- Performance of the player as a member of a team;
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the field;
- Positions played.
