Event Overview: The format of the day will be Round Robin matches in pools, followed by playoffs if required for CIS Team selection. Each match to consist of best of 9 games with a tie break at 4-4. All games to be short deuce. At the conclusion of the Championships, 8 girls will be named in the 2026 CIS Secondary Girls 18&U Tennis Team. The team list will be announced to the triallists on the day and be available to view on the CIS website.
