Venue: Pennant Hills Park – 25 Britannia St, Pennant Hills NSW 2120

Registration: 8.45am – Please do not enter the Pitch until advised by the CIS Staff at the Trials.

Event Start Time: 9.00am

Event Finish Time: 1.00pm, however for those who are selected in the CIS Team, it will be 2.00pm, due to a brief team Training Session.

Event Overview: The format of the Trial will be that all players will be involved in a Skills & Drills Session, followed by a number of modified matches.

What to Bring: All Players will be expected to bring their own Hockey Sticks, Shin Pads and Mouthguard (Players will not be permitted to Trial without a Mouthguard), Water Bottle and Sunscreen.

Goalkeepers are to bring their own Goalkeeping Kit.

Players should also bring their own food and drinks for the day of Trial.

Please bring a change of clothes – expect to play and train in the rain.

What to Wear: All triallists should wear their Association or School Sports uniform. No State or Representative uniform should be worn.

General Information

Selection Note: Selections (13 Boys/13 Girls) are based on the performance of students on the day.

Areas of performance considered:

- Skills exhibited by the player;
- Fitness level exhibited by the player;
- Performance of the player as a member of a team;
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the court/field;
- Positions played.
