Additional Championship Information

Withdrawals: Each Association is responsible for their own replacements, but this information must be supplied to the recorders at least 15 minutes prior to the race to avoid disqualification. Students that are not withdrawn and do not compete will be charged the Nomination Fee.

Spectators: Spectators are encouraged to stay in the grandstand area. NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE MARSHALLING AREA or ON POOL DECK, including the Warmup Area. This includes Parents, Guardians and Coaches.

Coaches: NO COACHES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE MARSHALLING AREA or ON POOL DECK, including the Warmup Area.

Officials have been allocated to supervise the Warmup Area.

N.B. The use of walkie talkies/headphones on pool deck is prohibited.

Parking: Parking is available in the Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre Car Park. First 4 hours free, \$7.00 per hour for each hour following.

First Aid: First Aid is provided by Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre.

Dress: Swimmers must strictly adhere to FINA rules and requirements regarding swimming gear. Association caps must be worn – this includes Relay events.

N.B. The use of walkie talkies/headphones on pool deck is prohibited.

Food & Drink: There will be food/service concessions available on day. Competitors are advised to bring their own food and drink with them.

Protests: Any protests must come through the Association Team Manager only.

Assigned Seating Areas: Please ensure you are seated in the area designated to your Association only. View [MAP](#).

NSWPSSA Swimming Championships: Will be held at Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre as a one-day event in 2026. The official date is Tuesday 28 April 2026. Swimmers who are selected to the CIS Swim Team must report to the Shane Gould Room to register for the NSWPSSA Championships, purchase their uniform and pay the levy.

All swimmers who participate at the CIS Championships should be available for selection in the CIS Team. If this is not the case, individual Association Delegates and Team Managers should be notified so that they can inform CIS prior to the Championships. Selections are based on the fastest 3 times per event.

Withdrawals from the CIS Swim Team must be made by 5pm, Friday 2 April 2026.



Fourth placegetters: are generally reserves. Should there be a withdrawal, students will be contacted via their school prior to the NSWPSA Championships.

Multi Class swimmers: will be ranked in Senior (11 & over) and Junior (10 & under) events for selection in the CIS team. These selections are subject to placing on the basis of classification and pathway qualifying standards.

Selection in the CIS Team will be confirmed on the CIS website following the CIS Championships.

NSWPSSA Selection:

N.B. Although 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13-year-olds may be selected in the CIS team, only competitors turning 10 – 12 in the year of competition can be selected at the NSWPSA Championships for the NSWPSA Team for School Sport Australia.

NSWPSSA Diving Championships: Will be held at Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre on Tuesday 28 April 2026. Divers who are selected to the CIS Dive Team must report to the Shane Gould Room to register for the NSWPSA Championships, purchase their uniform and pay the levy.

All divers who participate at the CIS Championships should be available for selection in the CIS Team. If this is not the case, schools should be notified so that they can inform CIS prior to the Championships. Selections are based on the first 3 places per event. All CIS medallists must submit NSWPSA dives to Diving Convenor, Mrs Chris Lang, at the CIS Championships.
