## 2026 NSWCIS Primary Rugby League Information

### **Selection Trials**

**Date:** Wednesday 22 April 2026

**Venue:** The Kingsway Rugby League Fields

**Registration:** 8.45am

**Event Start Time:** 9:00am

**Event Finish Time:** 3:00pm

**Event Overview:** At registration, players will be divided into approximately 8 teams and receive a jersey for the day. The Trial will consist of a 15-minute warm-up, followed by some drills and games.

At 1:00pm, selectors and team officials will meet and select 2 squads for a final game to begin at 1.45pm. Players not selected in the final game may leave. This game will be completed by 2:30pm, with the team to be announced after a selection meeting post-game.

Players selected in the CIS Primary Rugby League Team for 2026 are required to stay around for a team meeting and information session with parents.

**Canteen:** There will be a canteen running on the day, where there will be an opportunity to purchase food for lunch.

**Playing Positions:** All players will get time in their games to play in the Preferred Playing Position 1 listed in their registration. ***There is no guarantee that all players will get to play in their Preferred Playing Position 2.*** We have requested a second position to help with the shuffle of making sure all positions are covered for each team, therefore secondary positions will only be used when required.

**What to Bring:** Please bring your football shorts, socks and boots. Players should also bring their own mouthguards and protective gear (headgear) if required. Please bring a water bottle labelled with your name, and any food and snacks as required.

**What to Wear:** All triallists are to wear their school sport shirt before being given a jersey to wear for the duration of the trial. No State or Representative uniform should be worn. Players will be issued with a jersey to wear for the day which will be returned at the conclusion of the trials. Bring skins or similar in case you wish to wear these on the synthetic surface. Wet weather protection if raining and warm jackets for sidelines are also recommended.



## General Information

**Selection Note:** Selections are based on the performance of all students on the day.

Areas of performance considered:

- Skills exhibited by the player.
- Fitness level exhibited by the player.
- Performance of the player as a member of a team.
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the court/field.
- Positions played.
