Date: 23rd April, 2026

Venue: Hills Basketball Association, Caterson Dr, Castle Hill NSW 2154, Australia

Registration: Check-In Opens from 8:00am.

N.B. Please ensure you are fully registered prior to attending the Championships. If you are not fully registered, you will be unable to take the court.

Event Start Time: Games Commence at 8:30am, first round for 19&U starts at 9:15am

Event Finish Time: 3:30pm

Event Overview: The trial is an Association Team, championship style event. Games will be 2 x 15 minute halves with a 3 minute half time. No Shot-clock.

At the conclusion of the Championships, 10 players will be selected in the NSW CIS Team to compete at the NSW All Schools Event. The teams will be announced at the end of the Championships and will be available to view on the Basketball Trial page of the CIS website by 5pm Friday 24th April.

What to Bring:

Food, water and strapping tape if required.

The Hills Stadium Canteen will be open.

Please note while there will be first aid trainers attending the event, athletes will need to do their own preventative strapping if required.

What to Wear:

All triallists must wear their Association Basketball uniform. If you are part of a Barbarians team, uniform information will be distributed at a later date.



General Information

Selection Note: Selections are based on the performance of all students on the day.

Areas of performance considered:

- Skills exhibited by the player;
- Fitness level exhibited by the player;
- Performance of the player as a member of a team;
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the court/field;

CIS Team

There will be a player's levy and mandatory uniform costs associated with competing at the next level. Triallists should ensure they are available to the NSW State Championships if selected.



Application Process

1. Nomination	An email has been sent to the parent of any students nominated for a NSWCIS trial. This email will contain information about the event as well as a link to finalise the nomination.
2. Click the Link	<p>Click the link supplied in this email. If you already have a Dash account, this link should automatically log you in to your account, direct you to your application and ask you to select your child.</p> <p>If you have a Dash account but the child has not yet been added, click "Add another child".</p> <p>If you do not yet have a Dash account, go to step 3.</p>
3. Register	If you do not yet have a Dash account, the link you click in the above email will take you to a page which asks you to "Login" or "Register Now". Click "Register Now" and follow the prompts to create your account.
4. Add your Child	Once you have created an account you will be required to add your child to your account. Follow the prompts to create your child, including selecting their school and uploading any necessary medical information. This only needs to be done once per child.
5. Create Application	<p>Once you have completed the above steps you should be free to finalise the application via the "Create Application" button.</p> <p>If you have followed steps 3 and 4 and are no longer on the application screen, you can repeat step 2, or click the link supplied in the blue banner at the top of your Dash account.</p>
