Event Format: Championship-style Selection Trials

Event Overview:

The following format will apply for both the Boys and Girls Divisions:

- Students will play in their Association or 'Barbarian' teams and will play games against each Association.
- Team that is on top of the table at the end of the round games will be determined the overall winner of the Championships.
- Selected individuals will play in a Possibles vs Probables game to determine CIS Teams.

At the conclusion of the trials:

- 14 students will be named in the 2026 CIS Primary Boys Touch Football Team
- 14 students will be named in the 2026 CIS Primary Girls Touch Football Team

The team lists will be announced to the triallists on the day and be available to view on the [Touch Football](#) Sport Page of the CIS Website.

What to Bring: Please bring all snacks and lunch, along with plenty of water. There will be no canteen available on the day.

What to Wear: All triallists should wear their Association Uniform or School Sports Uniform/School Touch Uniform if you have one (Barbarian Teams). No State or Representative uniform should be worn.

Selection Note: Selections are based on the performance of all students on the day.

Areas of performance considered:

- Skills exhibited by the player;
- Fitness level exhibited by the player;
- Performance of the player as a member of a team;
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the court/field;
- Positions played.
