**Date:** 13th May, 2026

**Venue:** Pittwater Rugby Park, 1472 Pittwater Rd, Warriewood NSW 2102, Australia

**Registration:** 9:00am

**Event Start Time:** 9:30am

**Event Finish Time:** 3:00pm

**Event Overview:** Triallists will be placed in Barbarian style teams for match play. At the conclusion of the trials, up to 40 boys will be selected to attend the Rugby League Camp/Phase 2 trial. The successful students selected to progress through will be announced via the Rugby League Sport page of the CIS website on Wednesday evening and successful players will be emailed.

**What to Bring:** There are places to access food close to the venue, however it is recommended that students bring their own snacks, lunch and water.

**What to Wear:** Jerseys will be supplied, however, students will be required to bring their own boots, playing shorts, footy socks, mouthguards and any protective equipment such as headgear.

Wet weather protection if raining and warm jackets for sidelines.

Strapping tape if required. Coming pre-strapped will also save time.



## General Information

**Selection Note:** Selections are based on the performance of all students on the day.

Areas of performance considered:

- Skills exhibited by the player;
- Fitness level exhibited by the player;
- Performance of the player as a member of a team;
- Attitude and behaviour of player both on and off the court/field;

There will be a player's levy and mandatory uniform costs associated with competing at the next level. Triallists should ensure they are available to the NSW State Championships if selected.



## Application Process

<b>1. Nomination</b>	An email has been sent to the parent of any students nominated for a NSWCIS trial. This email will contain information about the event as well as <b>a link to finalise the nomination.</b>
<b>2. Click the Link</b>	<p>Click the link supplied in this email. If you already have a Dash account, this link should automatically log you in to your account, direct you to your application and ask you to select your child.</p> <p>If you have a Dash account but the child has not yet been added, click "Add another child".</p> <p>If you do not yet have a Dash account, go to step 3.</p>
<b>3. Register</b>	If you do not yet have a Dash account, the link you click in the above email will take you to a page which asks you to "Login" or "Register Now". Click "Register Now" and follow the prompts to create your account.
<b>4. Add your Child</b>	Once you have created an account you will be required to add your child to your account. Follow the prompts to create your child, including selecting their school and uploading any necessary medical information. This only needs to be done once per child.
<b>5. Create Application</b>	<p>Once you have completed the above steps you should be free to finalise the application via the "Create Application" button.</p> <p>If you have followed steps 3 and 4 and are no longer on the application screen, you can repeat step 2, or click the link supplied in the blue banner at the top of your Dash account.</p>
