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2026 NSWCIS Primary Athletics Championships - EDM

The 2026 NSWCIS Primary Athletics Championships will be held at Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre on Friday 4 September 2026.

Please read through the following information carefully in preparation for the event.

Venue Entry and Parking

The 2026 NSWCIS Primary Athletics Championships will take place in the Competition Arena. Venue entry for all competitors, officials and spectators will be through the Main Pedestrian Entrance accessed from Edwin Flack Avenue (Gates E and F).

Parking is recommended in the P2 Car Park. Parking tickets can be validated for \$24 flat rate on the day. *Please attend the Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre Reception to obtain a parking voucher.*

Footwear and Spikes

- All competitors must wear footwear.
- In all sprint events (100m, 200m and Relays) competitors may wear spiked shoes. The length of spiked shoes must be no more than 7mm.
- *Athletes under 14 years of age (i.e. Primary students) who are wearing spiked shoes are NOT required to use starting blocks but have the option to do so.*
- In all jumping events, competitors may wear spiked shoes. In jumping events the following spike lengths apply:
 - Long Jump - maximum 7mm
 - High Jump - maximum 9mm
- In the 800m and 1500m distance events, spiked shoes are NOT permitted.
- Only 'Pyramid' or 'Christmas Tree' spikes (also called compression tiered spikes) are to be used on the track for athletic activity. Needle Spikes are not permitted.
- Spikes are only permitted on the Competition Arena and must not be worn in spectator areas or indoors.

Merchandise

NSWCIS Merchandise will be available for purchase on the day of the event from Valour Stand. The Stand will be located inside the Main Pedestrian Entry in the forecourt of the Competition Arena. Contactless payment only - no cash.

NSWCIS Primary Athletics Team

All athletes who participate at the NSWCIS carnival should be available for selection in the CIS Team in the events in which they compete. Should this not be the case, individual Association Delegates and the Convenor should be notified so that they can inform the selectors prior to the meet. Generally, only those who compete at the NSWCIS Championships will be eligible for selection in the NSWCIS Primary Athletics Team. Usually, selections will be based on the top 3 placegetters per event and the NSWCIS Selection Policy. Changes at the NSWPSSA Championships due to illness or injury will be at the discretion of the Team Managers.

Fourth placegetters: are generally reserves. Should there be a withdrawal students will be contacted via their school prior to the NSWPSSA Championships.

Multi Class Competitors: will be ranked in Senior (11 & over) and Junior (10 & Under) events for selection in the CIS team. These selections are subject to placing on the basis of classification and pathway qualifying standards.

Selection in the NSWCIS Team will be confirmed on the CIS website following the CIS Championships.

NSWPSSA Selection: N.B. *Although 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13-year-olds may be selected in the CIS team, only competitors turning 10 – 12 in the year of competition can be selected at the NSWPSSA Championships for the NSWPSSA Team for School Sport Australia.*

This team will compete at the [NSWPSSA Athletics Championships](#) to be held on Wednesday 21 and Thursday 22 October 2026 at Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre.

NSWCIS Primary Team Registration and Uniform

Competitors successful in gaining a position in the NSWCIS Primary Athletics Team will need to report to the **Madison de Rozario Room** following their event to register, pay the Team Member Levy, and purchase Mandatory Uniform Items.

Costs associated with competing at the next level include the Team Member Levy and Mandatory Uniform Items.

Please note: *Valour Sport is the CIS Official Merchandise partner. CIS Team Uniform must be Valour branded.*



NSWCIS Primary Team List

A final NSWCIS Primary Team List will be available to view on the [Primary Athletics Sport Page](#) of the CIS Website by Wednesday 9 September 2026.

Team Members who did not attend the Team Room to register, pay the Team Member Levy, and purchase Mandatory Uniform Items on the day of the Championships will be contacted directly via email following the Team List announcement.

N.B. *It is important that competitors attending the NSWCIS Championships are registered to the NSWCIS Primary Athletics Portal in DASH prior to the event, to ensure they can be contacted.*

Additional Championship Information

Spectators: Spectators are encouraged to stay in the grandstand area. NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE ARENA. This includes Parents, Guardians and Coaches.

First Aid: There is a First Aid Room at Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre and an attendant will be present throughout the day. The First Aid Room is located under the main grandstand at the end of the 100m track. Students who use asthma puffers or Epi-Pens should have them at the Championships.

Dress: Competitors must compete in their Association Uniform.

Food & Drink: There will be food concessions available at the venue. NO glass permitted in the venue (bottles, containers etc). Strictly NO commercial food (McDonald's, KFC etc). The Athletic Centre is a fully catered venue.

Weather: The NSWCIS Primary Athletics Championships will go ahead regardless of the weather. In adverse conditions students should come prepared with extra clothes for after their event. Some events may be delayed or cancelled at the discretion of the Championship Manager if the nature of the event causes safety concerns due to the weather conditions.

Personal Marquees: Unfortunately, spectators will be unable to bring and set-up their own personal gazebos. This is a decision enforced by SOPAC to ensure the safety and welfare of all Competitors and Spectators.
